SAVE OUR SCHOOL'S (SOS) FUNDS (RAISER)

Last year, the Kolter Parent-Teacher Organization (PTO) raised over \$79,000 to enhance your child's educational experience. Kolter PTO raised funds for the cafeteria upgrade, library, science lab, and art programs. Kolter PTO also provided our teachers with money for their classrooms, professional development, training and so much more.

Due to state budget cuts the PTO's financial role is more important than ever. **The school has lost \$275 per student** in funding for the 2011-2012 school year. Although we cannot provide funding to pay teacher salaries directly, we can fund hourly consultants, equipment, materials and training as requested by the administration to help make up this shortfall.
